Pre-Registration Instructions

Auction Rules

1. Items will be sold in the order received. Pre-registered items will be numbered and sold first in the order received. Items registered at the door will be sold after pre-registered items.
2. Seller may protect himself by designating a minimum selling price. This minimum may be reduced by the seller at the time of sale if the minimum cannot be met.
3. Seller will pay a 10% fee (minimum of \$2.50) for each item sold and a \$3.00 fee for each unsold item. This fee will be collected at the time of check-out and will be shown on the sellers' invoice.
4. The minimum bid for each item is \$15.00. Items should be grouped to assure the item will sell at or above that minimum. Multiple Items will NOT be combined at the time of sale to meet the \$15.00 minimum. Items not getting a \$15.00 minimum bid will be marked as "No Sale" and the \$3.00 fee will be assessed to the seller.
5. Payment will be by cash, check or credit card. Note that a 3% charge will be added to credit card transactions to cover required fees.
6. Buyers and sellers are responsible for removing items from the premises upon completion of the auction. Any items not collected by the buyer/seller at the end of the auction will be disposed of at the discretion of the Auction Coordinator.

Pre-Registration:

1. Download and print the pre-registration form at:

2. Complete the seller contact info on the top of page 1 (if there are multiple pages, please include the seller's name at the top of each page.)
3. Complete the item description, minimum sale price and donation designation for each item. (Please pay close attention to rule number 4 concerning minimum price. Individual items such as servos, glow engines, 72Mhz radios will not likely meet this minimum. Group items to assure the \$15.00 bid can be achieved.)
4. Mail the completed forms to Kevin Hyde, 15442 Seward St, Omaha, NE 68154 along with a check for \$5.00 for the registration fee and a self-addressed, stamped envelope. **All pre-registration requests must be received by September 28 to allow processing time.**
5. A form will be returned to you identifying your seller number, Item numbers and stickers to be applied to the items to be sold. Item Cards will be printed for you and will be given to you at the auction registration table.
6. Apply the stickers to the appropriate items and bring them to the auction on October 8. The auction begins at 10:00. **All items must be on the tables by 9:00 AM to allow buyers to peruse the items prior to the bidding process.**
